

# BRUSH CHART

## FLAT

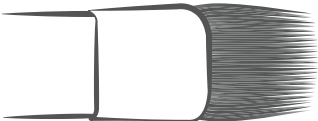
**Good for:** bolder strokes, large washes, filling wide spaces



- Can use it on its edge for thinner lines.
- Creates straight edges and stripes.
- Can be great for varnishing.

## BRIGHT

**Good for:** short, controlled strokes



- Can handle thick, heavy color.

## ROUND

**Good for:** outlining, detailed work, controlled washes, filling in small areas.



- Creates thin to thick lines - depending on pressure applied.
- Use with thinned paint rather than thick paint.

## RIGGER

**Good for:** fine lettering and lines.



- Can hold a lot of paint and create long, thin lines.

## FILBERT

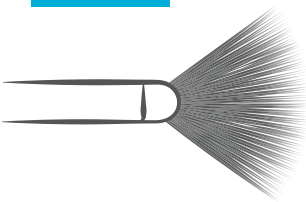
**Good for:** blending, soft, rounded edges like flower petals.



- Very versatile.
- Can create curves like a round but cover more space.

## FAN

**Good for:** blending and feathering.



- Can create textural effects like grasses, clouds, and leaves on trees.
