

APPLYING CONTRASTING COLORS

The word contrast is a principle of design and refers to the arrangement of opposite components. Examples include light vs. dark, short vs. tall, bumpy vs. smooth, etc. At times, it is useful to add a contrasting color scheme to one's artwork to emphasize the elements of art. Colors that are opposite of each other on the color wheel are good places to start when trying to think of a contrasting color scheme. Below are examples:
